CALIFORNIA NORTHSTATE UNIVERSITY TO OFFER COVID-19 VACCINATION AND FLU CLINIC AT SALAM ISLAMIC CENTER ON MARCH 4TH

WHAT: California Northstate University (CNU) will offer a COVID-19 vaccination and flu clinic on Friday, March 4th from 1p.m. to 5p.m. at the Salam Islamic Center.

In partnership with the California Department of Public Health & Health Net, the vaccination and flu clinic will offer COVID-19 vaccines and flu shots to adults and children ages 5 and older. Interpretation services will be provided in Arabic, Dari/Farsi, Pashto, and Urdu.

“We are proud to be able to provide vaccinations and flu shots to the underserved Islamaic community,” said Dr. Alvin Cheung, President and CEO of California Northstate University. “We urge anyone who has not yet received their COVID-19 vaccines or flu shot, even if they are not a part of this community, to come on Friday.”
