

Tuition and Fees

The cost of attendance is an estimate of expected educational expenses for a period of enrollment. These educational expenses are calculated as described below and apply to all students enrolled in the Pre-Medicine Post-Baccalaureate program at California Northstate University:

All tuition and fees for each semester are due and payable 10 business days prior to the first official day of class with the exception of new incoming students. For all new incoming students, please follow the payment

Living Expense Checks are usually ready for pick up 10 business days after the semester (Fall or Spring) has

started.
