Role Purpose and Responsibilities:

A track record of drug synthesis or translational research in drug discovery is preferred.

Applicants are expected to have a Ph.D., or equivalent degree as well as postdoctoral training. The successful candidate will be expected to establish and maintain a dynamic research program as a part of drug discovery group and to participate in our pharmaceutical science and medical student training programs. Teaching relevant topics in graduate programs and College of Pharmacy as well as College of Medicine is also expected.
