Job Classification: FTE as assigned, part-time.

Applicant cover letter should address prior teaching experience at the undergraduate level. CV should list all courses in the area of economics that the applicant has previously taught.

Education and Experience: Minimum of master's degree in Economics or related field; doctorate is preferred. Teaching experience in Economics is highly desired. Salary is dependent upon qualifications and relevant experience. Official university transcripts may be required upon hire.

Job Description: Part-time faculty are expected to maintain the highest standard of classroom teaching excellence, adhere to college policy, and hold regular office hours for student assistance (two hours per week). Part-time faculty may also be asked to attend regular meetings with course lead faculty to maintain alignment with institutional and course learning outcomes.
