



Adjunct Faculty Position: Differential and Integral Calculus, California Northstate University College of Health Sciences (CNUCHS), Rancho Cordova, California, USA

Job Classification: FTE as assigned, part-time.

Closing Date: Position Open until Filled.

Review of Applications: Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Spring semester applicant review will begin November 1st.

Anticipated Start Date: January 2, 2019.

Reporting Responsibility: Reports directly to the Chair of the Science and Math Department.

Job Description: Adjunct faculty is expected to teach Differential and Integral Calculus (MATH130), which covers limits, derivatives, and integrals of various types of functions. In addition, adjunct faculty is expected to maintain the highest standard of classroom teaching excellence, adhere to all college policies, and hold regular office hours for student assistance (2 hours per week). Specific questions regarding course content, required qualifications or additional application materials should be addressed directly to the Chair of the Science and Math Department.

Responsibilities:

- Teach Differential and Integral Calculus using best teaching practices.
- Make yourself available at least two hours per week to meet and help students.
- Attend regular meetings with lead faculty mentor and maintain alignment with institutional and course learning outcomes.

Minimum Qualifications:

A master's degree in the subject area is the minimum requirement, although a doctorate is often preferred (and ABD's may be considered). Teaching experience in the subject area is generally highly desired and may be required. Salary will be dependent upon qualifications and relevant experience. Official Transcripts may be required upon hire.

Applicants should submit:

- Cover letter of interest that addresses qualifications, experience and career goals.
- Curriculum vitae.
- Supplemental Application (Heidi Please attach Supplemental Doc).
- Names, addresses, and telephone numbers of at least three (3) references who can be contacted by the Search Committee and who can speak to the candidate's professional qualifications.
- Optional materials may include: relevant evaluation materials, certificates, and/or professional experience.
