## The Role of Psychologists in Medical Settings

Originally from the East Coast, Dr. Stephanie Smith completed her undergraduate studies at Towson University outside of Baltimore, MD. From there she moved to the Washington, D.C. metro area to complete her Psy.D. at the American College of Professional Psychology, Argosy University- Washington, D.C. While in school, she specialized in eating disorders and neuropsychological assessment.

After completing an internship with a hospital center in Pennsylvania specializing in integrated health psychology, she moved to California to pursue residency with dual focus on integrated health psychology, and eating disorders. She has remained within the hospital setting working as a health psychologist in clinics including primary care, pediatrics, lifestyle medicine, women's health, and bariatric surgery.

Dr. Smith is a diplomate of the American and International Boards of Lifestyle Medicine since 2018. She is the Chair of the psychologist service area in the medical center, and responsible for the psychological testing service. She offers regular CEU/CME trainings to the medical center, supervises medicine and psychologist residents, and works as an integrated consultant for primary care treatment of eating disorders. She also works part-time as a private practice clinician.
