SUMMARY

The College of Dental Medicine, California Northstate University (CDM CNU) is seeking Pediatric Dentistry Faculty to oversee dental courses as part of the Doctor of Dental Medicine (DMD) program.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Work with Dean and Accreditation team in all aspects of functions and activities including, but not limited to gathering & presenting data relevant to demonstration of compliance with accreditation standards.
- Collate Student and faculty research activities, publications, grants, and other research activities relevant to demonstrate student & faculty research of the accreditation standards.
- It is essential that the incumbent understand the accreditation standards and learning outcomes that must be addressed in the integrated behavioral science course. These must be reviewed this with the academic or curriculum dean. All faculty who teach in this course must share this understanding.
- Prepare teaching and learning materials, in pediatric dentistry.
- When not actively teaching pediatric dentistry the incumbent will teach general dentistry.
- General Dentistry faculty are expected to review all student learner material prior to each learning session.
- Teaching and Learning modules for faculty are provided as part of the onboarding process, and all faculty must review this material in addition to other onboarding processes.
- All faculty must attend each weekly Grand Rounds presentations and apply or reference as much of the presented information as possibly during the following week.
Faculty are expected to stay current with evidence-based approaches to dentistry as well as teaching and learning, utilizing the resources provided by the College.
- Course content is developed by the Course Director and in a collaborative process at the College level. In order to ensure that the final program for our learners addresses all learning outcomes, and is not



unnecessarily repetitious, General Dentists who wish to develop educational materials will do so with their Course Directors or provide suggestions via the centralized Curriculum Database.

QUALIFICATIONS: Required

- DMD/DDS and eligibility for CA dental license. (Candidates with overseas dental licenses must also have a US DDS/DMD training or Specialty training in a CODA approved program).
- Successful completion of a CODA-approved pediatric residency program.
