**SUMMARY:** The California Northstate College of Dental Medicine is seeking Dental Simulation Laboratory Dispensary Staff to assist pre-clinical Course Directors in supplying, maintaining and running the dental simulation laboratory for Dental Students in the Doctor of Dental Medicine 4-year program.

This position will report directly to Joel Whiteman, DDS and fall under the Office of Academic Affairs. This role will support the pre-clinical program in Dentistry and ensure that simulation laboratory remains operational at all times. It is critical that the incumbent collaborate and interact positively with staff, students and faculty.

## Responsibilities:

- Follows the University values by which we will all align: WE CARE (http://www.cnsu.edu)
- Completes and maintains Health and Safety, Infection Control, FERPA training.
  Additional training will be assigned as required.
- Management of instruments through the central sterilization following their use with autoclaved extracted teeth.

- Generating and tracking purchase orders for the Simulation lab and ordering all needed equipment and supplies; maintaining inventory at all times and utilizing digital supply management software.
- Submit, track, receive, process, and follow-up on orders and invoices. Send documentation of confirmed deliveries to the business office as requested.
- Arranges and prepares supplies/instruments/equipment/teaching resources for running classes. Preparation ensures classes can start on time.
- Coordinates with course directors to ensure appropriate supplies are ordered and received before the course is to be offered.
- Coordinates with CNU facilities management, CNU information technology, and outside repair personnel to maintain proper function of the sim lab and related equipment.
- Maintains an accurate log of instruments in need of repair and/or replacement of handpieces/instruments and oversees timely repair/replacement of handpieces and ordering of replacement instruments.
- Maintains dispensary and simulation laboratory in a clean and orderly fashion.
- Follows appropriate protocols for materials and equipment handling.
- Reviews Safety Data Sheets for all materials that will be handled and ensures correct handling.
- Maintains an accurate account on the computer of items scanned out and in from the dispensaries.
- Present during all simulation lab courses, setting up courses per daily exercises, and assisting in clean-up following classes.
- Assists in the check-in, setup, and check-out process of dental benches each academic year.
- Performs other related duties as assigned or requested.
