- DMD, DDS, PhD, MD or equivalent.
- Experience in teaching applied biomedical science and using a case-based format is essential.
- Knowledge of teaching and learning practices
- Ability to develop, use, and continually update, the latest in scientific knowledge and technology in teaching and learning.

- Experience teaching in a “small group learning” format is preferred.
