The candidate must demonstrate pedagogical expertise and content knowledge. This position is 100% in person, on campus. Faculty are expected to maintain the highest standard of classroom teaching excellence, adhere to college policy, and hold regular office hours for student assistance.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plan courses and prepare syllabi for approval by the curriculum committee.
- Work in a collaborative manner with other colleagues to provide exemplary academics.
- Make effective use of appropriate technology, learning software, and the learning management system in course delivery.
- Develop an effective teaching style informed by best practices in education literature.
- Perform data collection related to monitoring of program and general education learning outcomes as needed to fulfill assessment requirements and to monitor student success.
- Communicate effectively with students regarding course content, assignments, and exams.
- Keep regular office hours for students, provide tutoring assistance as needed, and perform student advising duties.
- Keep active in academic field of specialization through professional development, scholarly research, publishing, and professional activities.
- Serve on college and university committees and engage in university and community service including development of outreach activities.
- Participate in college and university programs to recruit and retain students.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS (Minimum):

- A master's degree in physics, or related field with college teaching experience. Demonstrated ability to develop innovative teaching strategies, and experience working with diverse groups.
- Preferred _ Two (2) years of experience teaching at the college level.
- Experience with education technology, such as learning management software (Canvas, Blackboard, etc.) is preferred.

WORKING ENVIRONMENT:
