SUMMARY: The Facility Technician works to keep the facilities in good repair while following CNU policy and procedures and upholding CNU's core directives. They are expected to be self-motivated, and able to work independently with little supervision. The facilities technician should be knowledgeable in building systems repair, and be able to work seamlessly with vendors, students, and staff. Basic knowledge of hand tools and power tools is a necessity.

- Understanding of routine and preventive maintenance scheduling and inspections

- Skill in using, maintaining, and troubleshooting various hand and power tools
- Attention to detail and good time management
- Communication, teamwork, and problem solving
