

How to do a Basic Search

You will see five “tabs.” Use **Basic Search** to start!

Enter in a search word or phrase in the search bar. The results will consist of articles, journals and books containing one or more of the words you enter in the search bar.

Next, your search results:

A “Search history” box will appear above your search. This box will list each search you make and tell you the number of results within each search.

To see a list of your results, you can either select “Display results” at the top of the page, or scroll down past “Basic Search.”
